

Covid-19 Roundtable How can Australia deliver during (and after) Covid-19?

CPD's special Zoom roundtable on Covid-19 is being held on the evening of Monday 30 March 2020 instead of our Menadue Oration, which has been postponed. The Oration by Professor Megan Davis was to address the question: "Can Australia Deliver?". Instead, a smaller group will come together via Zoom and focus on: *how can Australia deliver during (and after) Covid-19*?

The roundtable will begin with a conversation with Professor Ian Goldin, Professor of Globalisation and Development at the University of Oxford. This will be followed by insights from government, business, health and community leaders on Australia's response to Covid-19. The bulk of the roundtable will focus on ideas submitted by participants that respond to the question above. We want the roundtable to highlight ideas that are impactful, measureable and transformative, and that will require coordinated efforts across government, business and the community to implement. These ideas should respond to the inevitable social and economic disruption faced by Australians because of Covid-19 but also have in mind the sort of society and economy we can rebuild off the back of this crisis. The roundtable will take place under the Chatham House Rule.
